This class is a 75 hour, Sales-person Pre-license class approved by the Georgia Real Estate Commission. With successful completion, students will be certified to take the state Salesperson exam administered by Applied Measurement Professionals (www.goAMP.com). AMP has a testing facility in Savannah.

Location of Class

Classroom is located at Vaden Support Center 12020 Abercorn Street, Savannah, GA 31419. Parking is available behind the building. Entrance to the Facility is on the side closest to CVS/Farah and Farah. Main Lobby entrance is a large glass front entrance.

Cost

Books and Materials

Books and materials are provided and there is no additional cost. These items are included in tuition.

Grading and Attendance

In order to successfully complete this course, you must attend 75 hours of instruction. There are 84 hours of instruction on the schedule. You may miss up to 4 classes, but **only 2** can be made up. However, it is not recommended you miss any classes.

Classwork that must be completed to be eligible to take the final exam:

- 75 Hours of attendance
- Take the Midterm Exam
- Complete Contract assignment
- Complete Valuation assignment
- Take and pass the final exam with 72% or greater

Books will be ordered based on the number of students who have paid 10 days prior to class beginning. If you pay later than 10 days prior to class start, you will risk not having a book for the first night of class, but you will receive a book on class night number two.
